<b>1.</b>	<p><b>Rehabilitation Bond</b>          DEM has determined the rehabilitation liability estimate to be \$90,602,749 based on the information you have provided. DEM currently holds a bond amount of \$87,775,000. Accordingly, an additional bond of \$2,827,749 must be paid within 6 six months from the date of this letter. This bond will be formally requested through separate correspondence.</p>
<b>2.</b>	<p><b>Public Liability Insurance</b>          Pursuant to Regulation 81 of the <a href="#">Mining Regulations 2020</a>, you are required to provide a copy of a certificate evidencing the insurance coverage over the tenement(s).</p>
<b>3.</b>	<p><b>Compliance Reporting</b>          You are required to submit an annual compliance report in accordance with your current reporting schedule. Please refer to the DEM <a href="#">website</a> for more information on the reporting requirements.</p>
<b>4.</b>	<p><b>Work, Health and Safety Compliance</b>          In accordance with Chapter 10 of the <i>Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA)</i>, you must meet the requirements for mine operators in South Australia, which include a notification for mining operations, the establishment of a Safety Management System, the identification of Principal Mining Hazards and development of a Principal Mining Hazard Management Plan. <b>5.</b>	<p><b>Native Vegetation</b>          The native vegetation clearance and the establishment of an on-ground Significant Environmental Benefit (SEB) set out in the Native Vegetation Management Plan attached to the Program Review is approved in accordance with my delegated powers under the <i>Native Vegetation Regulations 2017</i>.</p> <p>The SEB points required for the removal of this vegetation has been calculated as 1,973 points.</p> <p>SEB will be provided through purchase of SEB offset credits from Nature Foundation SA's Witchelina Reserve. If SEB credits cannot be purchased from Nature Foundation SA, then payment must be made into the Native Vegetation Fund.</p>
<b>6.</b>	<p><b>Water Permit</b>          Under the requirements of the <i>Landscape South Australia Act 2019</i>, a water affecting activity permit may be required. You are advised to consult with the South Australia Arid Lands Landscape Board to seek further information regarding permitting requirements.</p>

In addition to the requirements under the Mining Act, you are reminded that your operation will have other legislative requirements that you will need to comply with.
