LOW LEVEL OFFICIAL SUPERVISION - APT O&M SERVICES PTY LTD

I refer to a letter dated 25 January 2007 granting Origin Energy Asset Management Pty Ltd (OEAM) low level official supervision status, pursuant to Section 74 of the *Petroleum Act 2000* (the Act), for all pipeline operation activities. I also refer to your letter of 17 August 2007 advising PIRSA that, following the sale of OEAM to the APA Group, the pipeline operating group will be called APT O&M Services Pty Ltd.

It is acknowledged that as per your advice, all previously established pipeline operating procedures and safety management systems will continue to apply. It is also acknowledged that APT O&M Services has amended and submitted to PIRSA all critical pipeline operation documentation to reflect the name change.

In light of the above, I hereby classify under Section 74 of the Petroleum Act all pipeline operation activities carried out by APT O&M Services Pty Ltd as low level official supervision status.

Please be advised that under PIRSA's existing policy and in accordance with Section 74(5) of the Act, the licence fee for all licences operated by a low level official supervision operator is 50% of the prescribed fee.
