



## DRAFT Standard for dual reticulation infrastructure

### The Office of the Technical Regulator is developing the Standard for Dual Reticulation Infrastructure for the water industry in South Australia.

The purpose of the Standard is to prescribe the minimum requirements and responsibilities of all parties involved in dual reticulation infrastructure to ensure the safety and reliability of the water services provided to South Australian consumers.

The Standard will provide clarity on mandatory requirements related to the installation and connection of dual reticulation systems to dwellings and will enable the OTR to standardise industry practices to prevent non-compliance.

The Standard will be applicable to all new and modified dual reticulation developments in South Australia, and will be complied to by the water industry.
