LOW LEVEL OFFICIAL SUPERVISION - EPIC ENERGY PTY LTD

I refer to a letter dated 5 December 2000 granting Epic Energy SA Pty Ltd low level official supervision status, pursuant to Section 74 of the *Petroleum Act 2000* (the Act), for all transmission pipeline design, construction and operation activities undertaken under licences held in SA. I also refer to information on the current Epic Energy Group company structure provided by Russell Brooks in an email dated 20 December 2007.

In light of the information provided, as well as Epic Energy's record of compliance with regulatory requirements for pipeline activities in SA, it is considered appropriate that the existing low level supervision status be amended to apply to Epic Energy Pty Ltd and each of its wholly owned subsidiaries.

Please be advised that under PIRSA's existing policy and in accordance with Section 74(5) of the Act, the licence fee for all Pipeline Licences (PLs) operated by a low level official supervision operator is 50% of the prescribed fee
