MOOMBA INTERCONNECT PIPELINE - PL10

I refer to your letter dated 22 October 2002.

On the basis that operation of PL10 has been suspended indefinitely, and pursuant to Section 134(1) of the Petroleum Act 2000, I hereby indefinitely extend the time limits for the following reports and other obligations required under the Act and pipeline licence:

- Review of Statement of Environmental Objectives
- Fitness for Purpose Assessment
- Leakage Management Plan
- Conduct of and reporting in relation to Emergency Response Drills
- Annual Reports

I note your intention maintain the pipeline licence by payment of the annual licence fee. I further note your undertaking to keep me advised of any significant changes or alterations to the pipeline.

As acknowledged in your letter, you are obliged to ensure that all regulatory requirements are fulfilled prior to recommencing operation of the pipeline.
