Annual Report for Preliminary Survey Licence PSL 14

In accordance with Regulation 33 of Part 4 of the Regulations under the *Petroleum Act*, Origin Energy Retail Ltd (Origin) hereby submits to the Minister the annual report in respect of Preliminary Survey Licence PSL 14 (SESA Pipeline) for the licence year ending 29 August 2005.

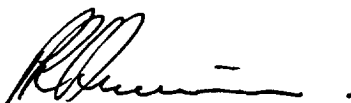
