Re: Consolidation of reporting requirements – PL 6 and PL 11

I refer to your recent discussions with Mr Richard McDonough regarding the consolidation of reporting requirements for Pipeline Licences PL 6 and PL 11, and advise that I have approved the consolidated reporting schedule as set out below:

- Annual Report (Petroleum Regulation 33): The submission of a consolidated annual report, based on the previous calendar year, and submitted by 31 March of the following year is hereby approved.
- Emergency Response Drills Reports (Reg 31): The next emergency exercise is to be conducted on PL6 by end June 2005 (with a report submitted within 2 months of the drill). Future combined emergency response drills shall be conducted at least every two years (in accordance with Reg 31).
- Fitness for purpose report (Reg 30): It is noted that the Fitness for Purpose (FFP) Report has been recently submitted. An FFP Report for PL6 is required by February 2008. This shall be a combined FFP for PL6/PL11, with the subsequent combined FFP due in February 2013.
- Incident Reports (Reg 32): As required.

In addition, a combined Statement of Environmental Objectives (SEO) needs to be finalised and approved. The PL 6 SEO was approved and gazetted in February 2004. This followed a low level public consultation process. The PL 11 SEO was gazetted on 3rd October 2002. Both SEO's are reasonably new and reasonably consistent. It is proposed the PL 6 SEO be amended to incorporate PL 11 and submitted for approval. To proceed, Envestra / OEAM are required to resubmit the consolidated document, which will then be be approved (given that the amendment is minor, refer *Petroleum Act* 2000 S102(5)).
