To the State Government and relevant Ministers

I am writing to voice my concerns over the proposed Terramin (Bird In Hand) mining proposal in Woodside. My Name is Tracey Jarrett and I have a property on Bird in Hand Rd, just metres from the proposed mining boundary.

My concerns are as follows;

Firstly the unknown risks to our water, with the unknown quality of water that will be injected back into our fragile water system. Just one mistake and we will all be paying heavily with unusable water which we all rely on.

I Have serious safety concerns for my children, grandchildren who along with us regularly use the roads that surround the proposed mining site. The intersection of Pfeiffer, Nairne and Riverview road is already a known blackspot and I fear that with the added use of 24 heavy trucks per day it will make for a very dangerous intersection.

We regularly host many interstate visitors and proudly show off our area. The beautiful vineyards the fresh produce and all the charm of the Adelaide Hills region. They all go home with many products and a wish to visit again. I have grave concerns that a mine in the middle of this pristine area will have huge consequences to the regions reputation as a "clean green" area will be severely damaged, if not destroyed.

I am also concerned and distressed about the ongoing disturbance that blasting and drilling the dust and continuous noise will have to the surrounding area. We moved to the area for its natural beauty and peace and having a mine just metres away severely impacts our everyday life.

I have also been informed that our property value has decreased with the Terramin's proposal to open the Mine. This not only affects myself but many property holders in the surrounding areas.

I implore the SA Government to say NO to mining in Woodside and NO to mining in the Adelaide Hills Please listen to the impact it will have on local business, jobs and the environment. And please listen to people like myself that will be closely impacted by your decision.
