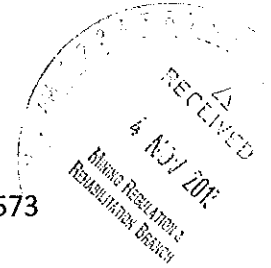

Re: Rex Minerals – Proposed Mining Licence

It is my belief that the mine **should not** go ahead in such a highly populated and ecological sensitive area because of the following:

**Toxic Dust** –(Copper and Uranium) Proposed mine is open pit. The dust will travel far and wide. You will probably have some in Adelaide. Will our rain water tanks be affected?

**Marine Park nearby** - What will happen to the marine life and gulf waters regarding dust and any leaks or accidents that end up in the Gulf St Vincent waters?

**Ground water contamination** – high risk of contaminating existing water tables. Proposed mine will be 1000 m deep.

**Conservation Area** – 30 m from proposed mine. Spider Orchids in the reserve are flowering for the first time in 6 years ... how will the toxins from the mine affect them?

As a Yorke Peninsula resident I don't want a massive mine next to our pristine gulf waters, adjacent to our tourism and retirement beaches and taking over our farming land.
