To Whom It May Concern,

My name is Rebecca Kemp, I am an Account Manager at Plasdene Glass-Pak, a packaging supplier to Bird in Hand and many other producers/businesses in the Woodside/Adelaide Hills region.

My main concerns about the Terramin mine going ahead and reopening is the effect the mining activities will have on visitors to the area and the possible effects/changes to water supply.

The increased noise, dust and traffic created by a mine operation may deter or disturb visitors to the many businesses in the area particularly winery Bird in Hand being that the entrance to the mine sits just 100m from their front door.

The fact that there has been no assurances that there will be no harm to water supply, levels and quality is a concern also as wineries and producers cannot successfully operate without water,

Increased heavy truck movement on these roads has the possibility to deteriorate the roads in the area making them unsafe and potentially create more roadworks/transport delays. Visitors will start to avoid these roads which will in turn begin to impact our business in the Adelaide hills when people decide not to visit the area.

Being that there is no way that testing can adequately and accurately predict the impact that underground blasting would have on the aquifer system, The best and only way to ensure the security of water supply to our many customers in the area is top this mine from going ahead. Why would we risk a 5 year mining operation that has the potential to devastate many if not all of the 744 tourism based businesses in the area.
