I wish to lodge my very strong objection to this proposal. It CANNOT be allowed to continue.

Although I live in NSW, my family come from the Yorke Peninsula area and I am just as concerned as they are about this current proposal. The current site proposed is very enormous and right in the middle of some of the most prime agricultural crop farming land in the country. The Yorke Peninsula area nearly always have a good harvest even if other areas are struggling. If this land was to be destroyed by mining it would be gone forever and the country as a whole will suffer for its loss. My uncle has a beachfront property at Blackpoint, which he has recently retired to. I was there in April and it is a beautiful pristine bay. If this mining was allowed to progress that would no longer be the case as the proposed mine site is very near by so the noise and dust levels created by the mining would be enormous.
