NAIN DOLOMITE QUARRY - REQUEST FOR EXTENSION TO SUBMIT A COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT PLAN

Thank you for your letter dated 15 March 2021, requesting an extension until 30 June 2021 to submit the Community Engagement Plan (CEP) for the Nain Dolomite Quarry.

The Department for Energy and Mining (DEM), notes that Kara Resources is currently developing a comprehensive CEP and your letter provides examples of work completed to date.

Given the justification provided by Kara Resources and recognising the importance of developing a CEP that meets the needs of the community, the quarry operator and the mining regulator, your extension request to submit the CEP by 30 June 2021 is approved.

DEM reminds Kara Resources that the CEP must be developed in consultation with all relevant stakeholders. It is recommended that a draft CEP be provided to DEM as soon as reasonably practical to allow a suitable timeframe for review.
