Subject: Opposition to Woodside Mine

I'm an Adelaide resident and am deeply concerned with the potential damage caused by Terramin's Woodside mine.

My main concerns are with the Inverbrackie Creek catchment area. These form part of the protected Mt Lofty Ranges prescribed watershed zone which supplies the city of Adelaide with 60% of its drinking water. The blasting and drilling operations are like to irreversibly damage this water source and affect the local businesses and homes up to 1.2 km away from the mine.

Secondly, the proximity to multiple wineries is highly likely to degrade their appeal for both locals and tourists. Bird in Hand, as an example, has their main hospitality area facing the proposed mine site only a few hundred meters away. This will likely have to be shut down, which will likely result in a loss of employment and degrade the quality of the business.

Overall, the potential damage that can be caused by this mine to the local area, over multiple issues, is significantly outweighed by the benefit it can deliver.

I do hope this is taken into consideration and the Adelaide Hills area remains the gem it is today.
